December 21, 2010 Town Board Meeting Minutes: A motion was made by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Dearing, to approve the December 21, 2010 Town Board Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Agenda for the January 4, 2011 Town Board Meeting: Motion by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda for the January 4, 2011 Town Board Meeting with the following additions: Request from Tom Tart and Dave Snyder to be on the Agenda Regarding Road Vacation; Dog Complaint Letter Regarding Kathleen Dammann. Motion carried unanimously.

Requests to be on the Agenda:

Tart/Snyder Road Vacation:

Tom Tart and Dave Snyder addressed the Town Board. They had surveys from Shoborg Land Services, Inc., showing the proposed road vacation and proposed turn-arounds that had been discussed at previous meetings. After discussion, a motion was made by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Dearing to pass Resolution 2011-01, a Resolution Calling for Public Hearing on Road Vacation. The road proposed to be vacated is that part of Mol Street, also known as Hollister Avenue NW, in Sugar Lake Heights. The Public Hearing will take place of Tuesday, February 1, 2011, 7 p.m., at the Corinna Town Hall.
