Meeting Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Class 5 Gravel Quote Opening:

Quotes for 5,000 cubic yards (more or less) of Class 5 gravel, crushed and stockpiled for use in 2013, were opened. (Gravel pit must be within 10 miles of Corinna Towns Hall.) The quotes were as follows:

Annandale Rock Products, Inc.: Proposal to crush and stockpile 5,000 cubic yards (more or less) Class 5 gravel. Material to meet MN DOT specifications. Graduation testing to be done by township at time of crushing. Materials to be removed on a continuing basis from May 15, 2013 through October 31, 2013. Location of pit is 14364 80th Street NW, Annandale. \$4.45 per cubic yard (in stockpile). Price includes Wright County gravel tax. Price does not include sales tax, if applicable.

Kolles Sand and Gravel, Inc.: Class 5 gravel per quote request: \$4.95 per cubic yard. Price includes crushing, material, and county tax.

A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to accept the low quote from Annandale Rock Products, Inc. for Class 5 gravel at \$4.45 per cubic yard. Motion carried unanimously.
