Official Minutes

Present: Chairman Richard Naaktgeboren; Vice-Chairman Chuck Carlson; Supervisor John Dearing; Clerk/Treasurer Mary Barkley Brown; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jennifer Kemp.

Meeting Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, November 20, 2012: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda for the Town Board Meeting of November 20, 2012 with the following additions: Arv Klemz letter of 11/19/12 to Corinna Township; Recognition of Planning Commission Vice-Chair Dan Shay. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, November 7, 2012:

A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Carlson, to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of November 7, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report: Reviewed.

<u>Maintenance Department Vacation Schedule</u>: After review, it was decided that no maintenance department vacations could be granted while Matt Smith is on vacation, as there would be no back-up snow plow driver. <u>Centra Sota</u>: Letter of 11/15/2012 was reviewed.

<u>Kent Courrier of Local 49</u>: Reviewed Kent Courrier's message that Maintenance Department health insurance rates for 2013 will increase \$20 per month, per man, starting March 1, 2013.

Requests to be on the Agenda:

1. <u>Chris Husom</u>: Ms. Husom is the new Wright County Commissioner-Elect. She stated that she has lived in Buffalo Township. She has gone to several area township meetings. She said that all townships have different personalities and needs, special to their area. She says she believes in local control and smaller government. Most control issues should be at the local level, when you are willing to take responsibility. She is an advocate for local control. In dealing with problem properties, she believes in peoples' property rights....but when they start to affect others' properties, we have to have standards.

Naaktgeboren stated that in the past we had virtually no communication with our Wright County Commissioners until Rose Thelen was elected. We had contact with Rose.

Husom responded that she is open to "open communication". It is the best way to prevent problems from becoming bigger. Then we can understand each others' points of view.

Other Business:

Arv Klemz Letter of 11/19/12 to Corinna Township: Reviewed letter thanking the Corinna Township Planning Commission for their fair and balanced resolution regarding a neighboring property's (PID# 206-080-002010) land alteration and conditional use permit request. Mr. Klemz wrote that the Planning Commission looked out for all the home owners involved and the protection of their homes and the protection of Sugar Lake from potential erosion and bluff damage. A copy of the letter was presented to Wright County Commissioner Rose Thelen.

<u>Planning Commission Board Terms</u>: The Corinna Board reviewed the Planning Commission Board Members' terms. Dan Shay and Lee Parks first terms end the last day of December, 2012. Larry Smith and Barry Schultz' second terms end the last day of December, 2013. Charlotte Quiggle and Steve Huff's second terms end the last day of December, 2014.

<u>Patricia Taylor:</u> Naaktgeboren introduced Patricia Taylor to the Town Board and audience. She stated that she and her husband have owned Taylor Land Surveyors for 30 years. She has worked with her husband in the business. She also works with people with disabilities, has been active in the Work Force Investment Board for 18 years, WCCA, and the Functional Industries Board. She believes in community involvement. She lives in Corinna Township between Bass and Clearwater Lakes, with deeded access to both lakes. She is familiar with both lake and inland properties. Rose Thelen commented that Patricia is "smart and dedicated". Dan Shay stated that Patricia would give the Planning Commission additional expertise and diversity.

A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to appoint Patricia Carlson to the Corinna Planning Commission / P and Z Board, for a three-year term beginning January 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Recognition of Planning Commission Vice-Chair Dan Shay: Dan Shay told the Town Board that he is moving to the Alexandria area and must resign from the Corinna Planning Commission. Naaktgeboren told Shay that it has been a pleasure to have him on the Planning Commission. Shay has been reasonable, and a good thinker. He always did his research and showed sound judgment. Shay responded that the Planning Commission is a great board that does what is best for the township, and residents of the township. The Planning Commission always tried to work with the residents, while staying within the county guidelines.
