CORINNA TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING Tuesday, March 3, 2015, 7:00 p.m. Corinna Township Hall 9801 Ireland Avenue NW, Annandale, MN

Meeting Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman John Dearing; Vice-Chairman Richard Naaktgeboren; Supervisor Chuck Carlson; Clerk/Treasurer Mary Barkley Brown.

Absent: Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jean Just.

<u>Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, March 3, 2015</u>: A motion was made by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Carlson, to approve the Agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, February 17, 2015: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Naaktgeboren, to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of February 17, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Crack Fill Quotes and Overlay Map:</u> Two quotes for crack fill were reviewed. Astech Surface Technologies was \$1.75 per pound. PLM Striping, Inc. was \$1.85 per pound. A motion was made by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Carlson, to award crack seal to Astech Surface Technologies at \$1.75 per pound. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Truck Quote</u>: Reviewed quote for 2015 Mack GU7 13 Tandem truck, from Nuss Truck and Equipment. Price is per state contract. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Naaktgeboren to approve purchase of truck, for \$112,998.94, plus \$1,669.94 for upcharge for the following model year, for a total of \$114,668.88; also not to accept trade-in offer of \$38,000.00, but to try to sell the old truck outright. Motion carried unanimously.

Reviewed quote for truck box from Towmaster. Price is per state contract. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Naaktgeboren, to purchase box for truck from Towmaster, without the tarp and tire chains which were specified on the quote, for \$105,118.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report: Reviewed.

7:30 p.m. Schlenner Wenner Audit Report 2014: C.P.A. Ms. Molly Thompson rescheduled to Regular Town Board Meeting on March 17, 2015 due to road conditions.

Open Recycling Quotes: The Town Board reviewed two proposals for collection and disposal of recyclable materials. Randy's Environmental Services Sanitation and Recycling's proposal included 5 year, 7 year, and 10 year contract options. Each of these options contained two sub-options, as well. Waste Management of MN, Inc.'s proposals contained 3 year and 5 year proposals. The Town Board discussed homestead versus non-homestead properties being included in the proposals. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Naaktgeboren, to table the issue to the 3/17/15 Regular Town Board Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. The Town Board advised Clerk Brown to add \$54,000.00 to the proposed 2016 recycling budget, which will be voted upon at the 3/10/15 Annual Meeting.

A motion was made by Naaktgeboren, seconded by Carlson, to require a 5 foot utility easement on the north, south and east sides of the property, nothing on the west side. Motion carried unanimously. Oleson will follow up after Bogart Peterson completes the survey. It was not complete due to snow.
