### **\*\*\*HELPFUL HINTS FOR LOADING\*\*\***

**JUNK AMNESTY** is a service for Corinna Township property owners. Please follow these guidelines when loading. If your load contains appliances, put them near the front of the load. They are unloaded last. If you have cement or shingles, load them on a pallet or boards so that they can be unloaded with the bobcat or loader. Keep scrap iron separate from the other material. If you are able bodied, please help unload your trash. Our "muscle power" supply is limited. Thank you for your cooperation.

## **BUILDING, SEWER, LAND USE, and ZONING PERMITS**

Building permits, sewer permits, land use applications and zoning applications may be obtained at the Corinna Township Hall or at [www.hometownplanning.com](http://www.hometownplanning.com). Office hours are: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. You may drop off completed applications and/or plans in the drop box after hours. All permit applications are to be dropped off at the Corinna Town Hall – whether related to building code, sewer permits or land use. All permits are to be paid for and picked up at the Corinna Town Hall.

## **TOWN BOARD MEETINGS**

Town Board Meetings are held the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays of each month, 7:00 PM at the Corinna Township Hall.

## **TOWNSHIP PROPERTY**

**Removal of black dirt, gravel, sand and/or salt from the Corinna Town Hall property is prohibited. Violators will be prosecuted.**

## **COMPOST, WOOD CHIPS AND FIREWOOD**

Compost, wood chips and firewood are available for residents to take from the piles on the Corinna Town Hall property.

## **EMERALD ASH BORER / CORINNA TOWNSHIP BRUSH PILE**

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture has notified Corinna Township that **we may NOT allow dumping of ash tree material in our brush pile on the Corinna Township Hall property.** This is to help slow the spread of Emerald Ash Borer. Thank you for your cooperation!

## **DOGS**

Corinna Township has obtained the services of Sue Eaton as the Animal Control officer. Most of her activities deal with lost or stray animals. ## **BURNING PERMITS AND FIRE WARDEN CONTACTS**

**Burning Permits:** Burning permits are required for open burning unless there is three inches of snow cover.

### **Burning the following items are strictly prohibited:**



- Hazardous wastes, industrial solid waste
- Demolition debris of commercial or institutional structures. (A farm building is not a commercial structure.) Burning of any structure should be referred to a forest officer.
- Salvage operations
- Motor vehicles
- Oils
- Rubber
- Plastics
- Chemically-treated materials
- Other materials which produce excessive or noxious smoke, such as, but not limited to: tires, railroad ties, chemically-treated lumber, composite board, sheet rock, wiring, paint, or paint filters
- Garbage, defined as discarded material resulting from the handling, processing, storage, preparation, serving, or consumption of food
- It is **never** permissible to burn household garbage.

## **PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON TOWNSHIP ROADS**

Grading and plowing equipment need to maintain the entire road surface and the Road Right-of-Way.

## **ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY**

No person may place, maintain, or allow any obstruction in a Right-of-Way. Items prohibited include, but are not limited to, retaining walls, fences, posts, structures, piled materials, hay bales, vehicles, trailers, campers, boats, pontoons, docks, boat houses, fish houses, equipment, junk, or any other items that interfere with the safe use or maintenance of the Right-of-Way. No person shall plant crops, trees, bushes, or shrubs within a Right-of-Way. No person may place watering systems or sprinkler heads within a Right-of-Way.

## **911 SIGNS**

If your sign is missing, call the township office for a replacement sign.

## **MAILBOX REMINDER**

Please make sure your mailbox post is in good condition. Check to see that it is firmly in the ground. Pressure from plowed snow can knock over a rotted mailbox post. Mailboxes will only be repaired or replaced if the mailbox support was damaged by a direct hit from township equipment. Mailbox supports (swing-away type) are available for purchase from the township.

## SINGLE SORT RECYCLING COMING TO CORINNA TOWNSHIP

Randy's is happy to announce the Corinna Township board has granted the recycle collection service to Randy's. The single-sort recycle program requires no sorting of your recyclable items. We will be delivering 65 gallon recycle carts the week of April 27th, 2015. The carts will have a tan lid with a list of acceptable items. *If you prefer a smaller 35 gallon or larger 95 gallon, call our service center after the township delivery has been done.* The final pickup in the old bins will be April 24th or 25th, depending on your current service day. After you receive your new cart, the bin should no longer be used for recycling collection. Feel free to take the bin and reuse it for the garage or basement storage.



All homesteaded properties will be receiving a cart. If you have a seasonal property and wish to participate in the recycle program, contact the Township by April 24th to be added to the initial cart delivery list. Seasonal homes may also contact the Township at a later date to enroll in the program. The Township phone number is 320-274-8049.
