Minutes

Meeting Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Vice Chairman John Dearing; Supervisor Larry Smith; Clerk/Treasurer Mary Barkley Brown.

Absent: Chairman Chuck Carlson; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jean Just.

Others in Attendance: Charlotte Quiggle.

Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, October 18, 2016: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Copies of the previous Meeting Minutes and this Meeting's Agenda are available for those attending this meeting.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, October 4, 2016: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board Meeting of October 4, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report: Reviewed.

Request for Gravel Quotes for 2017: This issue will be moved to the November 1, 2016 Agenda, as more information was needed from Maintenance Man Mark Miller.

Millings on Hollister AVE NW: Charlotte Quiggle addressed the Town Board. Quiggle requested that the maintenance men remove some of the millings on the road on or near 10829 Hollister AVE NW (Greg and Joni Selle) and 10789 Hollister AV NW (Charlotte Quiggle). Quiggle said that by widening the road surface with the millings, the Township had committed a "takings". Smith asked if there will be an erosion issue if the Township removes the new millings. Quiggle stated, "With Class 5 gravel there were terrible gullies, and I complained many times." Dearing will talk to Miller about removing some of the millings.

New Maintenance Shed: No action taken.

1. Planning and Zoning Administrator's Report: Reviewed.
2. Cedar Creek 9/30/16 Spoil Pile Plan Deadline and 10/15/16 Spoil Pile Removal Deadline: Permission received from all property owners 10/12/16. As of 10/18/16 the work is not completed.
3. Craig Schulz Letter of 6/27/16 Regarding Wolslayer Boathouse at 11416 Klever: Wolslayer is working with Schulz to remediate dilapidated building; No action taken.
4. Scott Deckert Letter of 7/21/16 Regarding Failing Septic at PID#206-000-331102: Deckert E-mail of 9/14/16; Deckert stated in an e-mail of 10/18/16 that he would send another letter to property owner.
5. Craig Schulz Letter of 8/16/16 Regarding Hazardous Building at 7179 Imhoff AV NW; Schulz E-mail of 9/14/16: No action taken.
6. Dogs Running at Large Complaint: A complaint was received regarding a dog running at large. Complainant stated that the dog owners reside at 8685 79th ST NW, Annandale. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to have Clerk Brown send a letter to property owner explaining the Township's Ordinance 1-2002, regarding dogs "running at large". Motion carried unanimously.
7. Wright County Planning Commission Notice of intent to Amend the Wright County Code of Ordinances: Second reading; A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, approving the proposed ordinance amendment, Section 155.108 Solar Energy Farms and Solar Energy Systems, with the following condition:

The Corinna Town Board feels that the time period for reviewing solar energy farms should be at least every 5 years – not the 30 year time period suggested by the language within the Wright County Ordinance. Motion carried unanimously. Clerk Brown will send the Board's comments to Wright County.

8. Pipeline Safety: Town Board completed questionnaire regarding pipeline safety.
9. Notice of Special Election: ISD 881 (Maple Lake Public Schools); Reviewed.
10. Vote Count Reporters: Reviewed.


Office of the State Auditor: E-Updates 9/30/16 and 10/7/16 were reviewed.

Payment of Claims:


