Minutes

CORINNA TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING Tuesday, June 6, 2017, 7:00 p.m. Corinna Township Hall 9801 Ireland Avenue NW, Annandale, MN

Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman John Dearing; Vice Chairman Larry Smith; Supervisor Chuck Carlson; Clerk/Treasurer Mary Barkley Brown; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jean Just; Corinna Maintenance Man Mark Miller.

Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, June 6, 2017: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to approve the Agenda with the following addition: Corinna P and Z Monthly Report for April and May, 2017. Motion carried unanimously. Copies of the previous Meeting Minutes and this Meeting's Agenda are available for those attending this meeting.

<u>Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, May 16, 2017</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board Meeting of May 16, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report: Reviewed.

Road Paving Quotes: Quotes to pave a portion of Ireland AVE NW from Mid MN Hot Mix and Knife River were reviewed. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Carlson, to accept the low quote from Mid MN Hot Mix for a portion of Ireland AVE NW, in the amount of \$16,820; and a quote of \$3,000 to add a 2 foot gravel shoulder. Knife River's quote was \$20,000. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Crack Fill Quote</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to accept Astech's quote of \$1.60 per pound for crack-fill. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Curbing Quote</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to approve curbing quote from Scott Mavencamp, in the amount of \$1,150. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Ken Yager</u>: Ken Yager addressed the Town Board. He presented his proposed assessor contract for years 2018-2019. A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to approve the contract. Motion carried unanimously.

Requests to be on the Agenda:

- 1. Casey Borer Road Vacation: Not in attendance. No action taken.
- 2. Kathy and Steve Irwin Road Vacation: Kathy Irwin presented a Petition signed by all abutting property owners,

to vacate a road as follows: That part of the 20.00 foot wide strip of land dedicated as a road on the recorded plat

of DE-O-NA-GA-NO POINT, Wright County, Minnesota, which lies within Lot 30 said DE-O-NA-GA-NO POINT.

A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to approve Resolution 2017-07, a Resolution Calling for Public Hearing on Petition to Vacate Road. Motion carried unanimously. The public hearing will be Wed., July 5, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town hall.

3. <u>Jim Gray – Proposed Ordinance Requiring Inspection at Central Location – Lake Sylvia, Lake John, Pleasant Lake:</u> Jim Gray was not in attendance. Russ Fortner took his place and addressed the Town Board. Fortner passed out a proposed Wright County Ordinance Amendment, pertaining to Inspections for Aquatic Invasive Species, for review and discussion.

4. <u>Vicki Greene</u>: 10507 Grunwald AV NW – Well is too close together to get holding tank; there is a 110' easement — Wants Township to vacate approximately 44 feet: Vicki Greene addressed the Town Board. She was with Charlie Kent, who is interested in PID#206-060-000120. They wondered if the Town Board thought it was feasible to ask for a road vacation so that there could be a holding tank placed on the property. The vacation would still leave a 66' Right-of-Way for the township road. The Town Board did not see any reason they should not apply for a road vacation.
