Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, May 16, 2017: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to approve the Agenda with the following additions: MAT Summer Short Courses. Motion carried unanimously. Copies of the previous Meeting Minutes and this Meeting's Agenda are available for those attending this meeting.

<u>Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, May 2, 2017</u>: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to approve the Minutes of the Regular Town Board Meeting of May 2, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report: Reviewed.

<u>Road Paving Quotes</u>: One quote was reviewed – for repair of Hemlock/80<sup>th</sup> Street NW, due to urgency of needed repair. A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson to accept quote of \$12,750.00, submitted by Knife River Corp., for repair and paving of portion of road where the pavement has failed. Motion carried unanimously. The Town Board is waiting for quotes from Mid-MN before opening the quotes for other areas that may need paving.

<u>Chip Seal Quotes</u>: Quotes from Pearson Bros. and Astech were reviewed. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to accept lowest quote for granite seal coat and fog seal, in the amount of \$38,642.28, from Astech. Motion carried unanimously.

Farm Rite Quote – Hydraulic Pallet Forks, etc.: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to purchase new 48" hydraulic pallet forks for \$2,047.50; new 74" low profile bucket for \$745.50; new 74" bolt on edge for \$250.00. All prices are MN State Bid prices. Motion carried unanimously.

John Bishop – Preliminary Plat Approval Extension:

Peter Ramme Letter of 5/2/2017 to Town Board Regarding Bishop Extension Request: Reviewed. Bishop addressed the Town Board to ask for a five year extension on a variance previously granted to allow for more than two years to seek final plat approval of an approved preliminary plat, PID# 206-000-013200. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith to grant a 5 year extension beyond the first 5 year period. The final plat would now be due 10 years after the date of the original preliminary plat approval on September 18, 2012 (September 18, 2022) and the conditions of the original October 16, 2012 variance would still apply regarding storm-water design requirements. Motion carried unanimously.
