# **BUILDING, SEWER, LAND USE and ZONING PERMITS**

Building permits, sewer permits, land use applications and zoning applications are available at the Corinna Township Hall or at <a href="www.hometownplanning.com">www.hometownplanning.com</a>. You may drop off completed applications or plans in the drop box after hours. Please bring these permit applications to the Corinna Town Hall.

# WINTER PARKING IN TRAVELED PORTION OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

No person shall park any vehicle, motorized or non-motorized, within any part of the traveled portion of a Right-of-Way during the hours of 12:00 midnight through 7:00 a.m. between November 1 and April 1.

# SNOWFALL PARKING IN TRAVELED PORTION OF ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

No person shall park any vehicle, motorized or non-motorized, within any part of the traveled portion of a Right-of-Way at any time during or after a snowfall until the entire traveled portion of the Right-of-Way is plowed to its customary width. Also - it is illegal to push snow across public roads. Snow must be placed on private property.

### **ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY**

No person shall place, maintain, or allow any obstruction in a Right-of-Way. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, retaining walls, fences, posts, structures, piled materials, hay bales, vehicles, trailers, campers, boats, pontoons, docks, boat houses, fish houses, equipment, junk, or any other items that interfere with the safe use or maintenance of the Right-of-Way. No one may plant crops, trees, bushes, or shrubs within a right-of-way. No one may place watering systems or sprinkler heads within a right-of-way.

### MAILBOX REMINDER

Please make sure your mailbox post is in good condition. Check to see that it is firmly in the ground. Pressure from plowed snow can knock over a rotted mailbox post. Mailboxes should be set 42" to 44" above the ground. Mailboxes will only be repaired or replaced if the mailbox support was damaged by a direct hit from township equipment. Mailbox supports (swing-away type) are available for purchase from the township.

## TOWNSHIP ROAD SUPPLIES

Please do not remove black dirt, sand, gravel or salt from the Corinna Town Hall property. Violators will be prosecuted.

## COMPOST, WOOD CHIPS AND FIREWOOD

Township residents may take free compost, wood chips and firewood from the piles on the Corinna Town Hall property. Only township residents may deposit materials onto the piles. No commercial dumping is allowed.

### EMERALD ASH BORER / CORINNA TOWNSHIP BRUSH PILE

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture has notified Corinna Township that we may not allow dumping of ash tree material in our brush pile at the Corinna Township Hall. This is to help slow the spread of Emerald Ash Borer.

### JUNK CLEAN-UP DAY

Junk Clean-Up Day will be held Saturday, July 28, 2018, from 7:30 AM to noon, at the Corinna Township Hall. You will receive a newsletter in July giving you more details about Junk Clean-Up Day.

#### BURNING PERMITS AND FIRE WARDEN CONTACTS

Burning Permits: Burning permits are required for open burning unless there are three inches of snow cover.

Burning the following items is strictly prohibited:



- -Hazardous wastes, industrial solid waste
- -Demolition debris of commercial or institutional structures. (A farm building is not a commercial structure.) Burning of any structure should be referred to a forest officer.
- -Salvage operations
- -Motor vehicles
- -Oils
- -Rubber
- -Plastics
- -Chemically-treated materials
- -Other materials which produce excessive or noxious smoke, such as, but not limited to: tires, railroad ties, chemically-treated lumber, composite board, sheet rock, wiring, paint, paint filters, mattresses, stuffed furniture
- -Garbage, defined as discarded material resulting from the handling, processing, storage, preparation, serving, or consumption of food
- -It is **never** permissible to burn household garbage.

#### FIRE DEPARTMENTS

Maple Lake Fire Department serves all parts of Corinna Township that are east of a north-south line dividing Cedar Lake. Annual Fire Department serves all parts of Corinna Township west of the north-south line dividing Cedar Lake.

### **DOGS**

Sue Eaton is the Corinna Township Animal Control Officer. Most of her activities deal with lost or stray animals. If you have a problem with a stray animal, contact Animal Control Officer Sue Eaton at 612-366-4370. Impounded animals are taken to the Annandale Veterinary Clinic – phone 320-274-3535.
