You may vote by absentee ballot by completing the absentee ballot application on website [www.sos.state.mn.us](http://www.sos.state.mn.us) and sending it to the Wright County Auditor Treasurer's Office-Elections; or by calling Wright County Elections at 763-682-7671 to request an absentee ballot application.

If you choose to vote at the Corinna Township Polling Place, the Elections will be open from 7 AM to 8 PM on Election Day, at the Corinna Town Hall. Please consider wearing a mask to protect the health of our election workers.
