SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES OR UNDERGROUND CONSTRUCTION AND STREET EXCAVATION WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

1. No work under this application is to be started until application is approved and the permit is issued. Permittee shall have a copy of this permit on the job site at all times.
2. Permittee agrees to conduct all work in accordance with Corinna Township Ordinances, including but not limited to the Right-of-Way Management Ordinance, Town specifications, and all applicable laws and standards.
3. Where work on the traveled roadway is necessary, traffic must be protected and all traffic control devices and partial road closures shall be in accordance with the Minnesota Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MN MUTCD).
4. Excavations must be cribbed when necessary depending on type of soil in order to prevent cave-ins.
 - a. No undermining of streets, curbs, bituminous trails, and/or sidewalks (except for boring) will be allowed.
5. Underground construction must be so constructed as not to harm or unnecessarily destroy the root growth of adjacent or ornamental trees.
6. Turf, sodded area will be sodded and other areas can be seeded. It is the permit holder's responsibility to maintain the sod/seed. 4" of topsoil is required.
7. No open trenching across bituminous surfaced roadways is allowed, unless no reasonable alternative exists and said trenching has been clearly depicted in the application materials and approved.
8. All back filling must be placed in 6-inch layers and thoroughly tamped, unless otherwise directed and material must be flush and even with the road surface when finally in place. No rock, unstable soil, or bituminous material shall be returned to the back-filled trench.
9. Finished surface, base, and sub-base, of road after excavation and back-fill, shall be at least equal in stability to finished surface, base, and sub-base prior to excavation. A minimum 6" class 5 gravel base material shall be placed at the upper surface of the excavated trench in roadways unless otherwise directed.
10. Bituminous and gravel surfaces shall be replaced according to Town specifications and shall match existing thicknesses.
11. If settlement occurs or excavation caves-in within one year from completion date, it shall be restored to its original condition by the holder of this permit.
12. No pole anchors, anchors, braces, or other construction shall be placed on roadway shoulder or within the clear zone except by special authorization.
13. Streets may not be closed to traffic unless expressly authorized by the permit and necessary notifications have been made.
14. No lugs shall be used on equipment traversing roadways, which will damage the road surface.
15. Roadside and/or site shall be cleaned up after work is completed. Any disturbed areas will be restored to existing conditions or better.
16. Within 24 hours, and during normal working hours, (no permits for any type of excavation on public property will be issued for construction on Saturday, Sunday or legal holidays, except for emergency repairs) the permit holder shall notify the Town Clerk that such work has been completed and is ready for final inspection.
17. No street excavation shall be allowed between November 15th and May 15th, except for emergencies.
18. Permittee agrees to promptly pay any additional costs incurred (over and above the initial permit fees) should issues arise during the performance of the work. Permittee further acknowledges that the Corinna Township will draw on the Performance Bond (or other financial security) if charges are not promptly paid.

FEE SCHEDULE:

One Time Registration Fee - \$200.00

Permit Fee - \$200 (for one thousand feet or less of new cable/pipe)
\$50 (for each additional one thousand feet of new cable/pipe)
