JUNK CLEAN-UP is a service for Corinna Township property owners. Please follow these guidelines when loading. If you have cement or shingles, load them on a pallet or boards so that they can be unloaded with the bobcat or loader. Keep scrap iron separate from the other material. If you are able bodied, please help unload your items. Thanks for your cooperation!

NEW VACATION RENTAL REGULATIONS ADOPTED – NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

In May 2020, after study of the issue by a Township committee and several public hearings to gather public input, the Corinna Town Board adopted a new Section 781 of the Corinna Township Land Use Ordinance entitled “Private/Vacation Home Rental” that regulates the rental of homes by the night or week. A portion of these regulations were effective in May and the remainder became effective on January 1, 2021.
