<u>Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, May 18, 2021</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve May 18, 2021 Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Arlene Marshall Trust Property - Public Hearing for Road Vacation:

Chairman Larry Smith opened the Public Hearing for public comments at 7:03 P.m. Smith asked if there were any public comments, twice. As there were no comments, Smith entertained a motion to close the Public Hearing portion of the meeting. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing to close the Public Hearing. Motion carried unanimously. The Public Hearing portion of the meeting closed at 7:04 p.m.

<u>Resolution 2021-08 Vacating Road</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve Resolution 2021-08, Vacating Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report, Calendar and Log Sheets: Reviewed. Steve Jost asked to get 100-200 yards of gravel from ARP. Town Board OK'd request.

Safety Recall Notice - Western Star ACM Ground Splice Pack: Reviewed.

<u>Terry Berggren Speeding Concern on 70th ST NW</u>: Jost said that a white 35 MPH sign is on the road. Clerk Brown will ask Sheriff's Department about flashing speed signs for 70th and 67th Streets NW. <u>Pete Edmonson Inquiry Regarding Jenkins AVE NW</u>: The Town Board stated that they have no plans to tar this portion of the road and it is not in the 2021 or 2022 budget.

<u>Tina Diedrick Question Regarding Hart – asphalt repair ends at 110^{th} </u>: Town Board members will check this part of the road to see what can be done.

Keith Heaton Inquiry Regarding Chip Sealing Kramer AVE NW from 120th ST NW to Tar on Top of the Hill Coming Off 108th ST NW: The Town Board stated that chip seal is only OK on certain types of soil. They don't feel the north end of Kramer is good enough to chip seal. The Town Board feels that chip seal is still in the research phase and do not plan to take up this request at this time. Carlson stated that the property owners could petition the Town Board to tar the road.

Sandy Shores at Sugar Lake Road: Two quotes were opened for paving. They were as follows: Knife River \$40,329.50 plus \$3,500.00 for shaping and compacting existing class 5; and Mid- Minnesota Hot Mix, Inc. for \$43,534.80 plus \$2,980.00 for prep of aggregate base and fine grading. A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to accept quote from Knife River for paving and for shaping and compacting existing class 5. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Corinna Township Cell Phone Policy</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve policy. Motion carried unanimously.
