Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, May 3, 2022: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda with the following additions: Dog Letter PID 206-147-001030; Resolution 2022-08 - 3 parcels Orderly Annexation; Spring Load Restrictions Removing May 13, 2022. Motion carried unanimously. Copies of the previous Meeting Minutes and this Meeting's Agenda are available for those attending this meeting.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, April 19, 2022: A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to approve the April 19, 2022 Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report and Calendar: Reviewed report. A number of items were discussed. They are as follows:

Thatch the cemetery? Answer – No;

Check culvert at 9840 Jeske Ave. NW. Sand washed down hill and filled in ditches;

On May 23 - Chloride will start on 4 areas that get done twice this season: 65<sup>th</sup> Street NW; Gowan Avenue and 80<sup>th</sup> Street NW; 105<sup>th</sup> Street NW - east and west; Gowan Ave. NW. Chloride on one-time application roads are scheduled May 25 and 26, June 1, 2, and 6 at this time;

Crack fill can be done on 2 extra roads that are due for sealcoat next year;

Look into bigger jetter system for cleaning out culverts. Could trade existing jetter;

Get quotes from Knife River and Mid-MN on possible paving this season;

1930 feet – Ireland Ave. NW from County Road 39 to Ingram – reclaim and re-pave;

Jeske Ave. NW and 98<sup>th</sup> ST NW area;

1,335 feet - 113<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW and 1,880 feet - Ingram Ave NW – both for information purposes for future paving;

3 road approaches need radius paved:

Ireland and 113<sup>th</sup> – by Fred Jude

Ireland and 114<sup>th</sup> – by Dave Stumpf

Ireland Ave. NW at Ingram Ave. NW;

Re-build Hart Ave. NW this year from 110<sup>th</sup> ST NW to the new road at Sandy Shores at Sugar Lake but pave next season or later this Fall. It is 1,850 feet from 110<sup>th</sup> ST NW to the new road at Sandy Shores at Sugar Lake. Several complaints received regarding water on Hart Ave. NW. 11173 Hart Ave NW – water goes over Hart Avenue there; Need landowner permission to go through yards. Go through Alama's property by his garage, 11211 Hart Ave. NW? Do not go through Schoenfelder, 11187 Hart Ave. NW;



Payment of Claims:


