Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance was at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Chuck Carlson; Vice-Chair John Dearing; Supervisor Larry Smith; Clerk/Treasurer Mary Barkley Brown.

Absent: Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Jean Just.

Others in Attendance: Steve and Diane Wiltermuth.

Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, June 21, 2022: A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to approve the Agenda with the following addition: New 2022 Corinna Recycling Calendar. Motion carried unanimously. Copies of the previous Meeting Minutes and this Meeting's Agenda are available for those attending this meeting.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, June 7, 2022: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve the June 7, 2022 Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report and Calendar: Reviewed. Carlson stated that he spoke to Southside Town Board Supervisor Marty Ferguson and asked him to stop grading 100th ST. NW, where Corinna had crowned the road.

A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Carlson, to have Central Applicators spray the wild parsnip in the township and the weeds on Hart Ave. NW – where the township is doing road reconstruction. The Wright County Weed Inspector rode with Steve Jost and confirmed areas that needed to be sprayed. Motion carried unanimously.

8270 Irvine Ave. NW – Water Issue: Property owner was not in attendance. No discussion.

Requests to be on the Agenda:

1. Brian Skluzacek, Sticks and Stones: Regarding Brush Pile – did not attend.
2. Steve and Diane Wiltermuth, 11955 Hart Ave. NW: The Wiltermuths addressed the Town Board in regard to road erosion at and near 11955 Hart Ave. NW. This portion of road has not been accepted by Corinna Township. A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing to dump gravel on the road once the property owners have engineered the road. Corinna Township equipment is too big to service this portion of road. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to have Granite Electronics replace batteries, at approximately \$800.00, and also circuit breaker and charger for approximately \$800 if needed. Motion carried unanimously.
 7. Orderly Annexation Draft: City of Annandale has not responded yet.
 8. Junk Clean-Up Day July 30, 2022: Went over list of volunteers and possible food vendor.
 9. Revised Planning Commission Meeting Dates 2022: Reviewed.
 10. Wright County Township Officers Association Dinner Meeting July 14 – 6:30 PM: Clerk Brown to RSVP for 3 attending – Dearing, Smith, and Carlson.
 11. Set-Up Fees for New Assessor: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to pay \$400.00 to Wright County to set up new assessor. Motion carried unanimously.
 12. New 2022 Corinna Township Recycling Calendar: Reviewed.
- Any Other Business That May Come Before the Board: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Smith, to pay John Dearing \$1,500.00 for use of his water and electricity for Corinna truck filling up to water the town roads this year, and for use of his field to burn the brush pile this spring. Carlson and Smith voted in favor. Dearing abstained. Motion carried.

Office of the State Auditor: E-Updates of 6/3/2022 and 6/10/2022 were reviewed.


Payment of Claims:
