JUNK CLEAN-UP is a service for Corinna Township property owners. Please follow these guidelines when loading. If you have cement or shingles, load them on a pallet or boards so that they can be unloaded with the bobcat or loader. Keep scrap iron separate from the other material. If you are able bodied, please help unload your items. Thanks for your cooperation!

NEW VACATION RENTAL REGULATIONS ADOPTED – NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

Feb. 15, 2022, the Corinna Town Board adopted a new Section 781 of the Corinna Township Land Use Ordinance entitled “Private/Vacation Home Rental” that regulates the rental of homes by the night or week. The February 2022 version modifies the May 2021 version adopted previously. Both versions require registration of all vacation rentals and for some to obtain interim use permits through a public hearing process. RECYCLING – NOW SINGLE SORT

The following are recyclable: aluminum beverage cans; metal food cans; glass bottles and jars (all colors); plastic containers and lids (#1-7); cartons – milk, soup, broth, wine, juice boxes; newspaper; cardboard; boxboard (cereal, cracker, shoe boxes); mixed mail (magazines, office paper, envelopes). Please have your recycling cart at the curb by 6:00 AM. Township General Funds are used to pay for the cost of this service.
