Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, June 4, 2024: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda with the following additions: Trails End Liquor License; Sugar Lake Access Brush Dumping Request; Sir Lines-A-Lot Proposal. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, May 21, 2024</u>: A motion was made by Carlson, seconded by Dearing, to approve the May 21, 2024 Town Board Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Open Quotes for Irvine AVE Paving Project</u>: Chairman Larry Smith opened quotes from 3 paving contractors, as follows:

Knife River \$84,410.50; Mid-MN Hot Mix \$119,048.44; MPM Minnesota Paving & Materials \$135,999.00.

Irvine AVE NW Engineer William Tessmer inspected all quotes and found all quotes were acceptable for Irvine AVE NW project as designed. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Carlson, to accept Knife River quote in the amount of \$84,410.50, with the condition that Knife River will start the paving after Wright Hennepin Electric project is finished on Irvine AVE NW, with date of substantial completion for paving road by Labor Day, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report and Calendar: Reviewed. A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Carlson, to purchase 200 yards of millings from Knife River, at a price of \$3.75 per yard, delivered. Motion carried unanimously.

Cement Road - Engineering: No engineering report yet.

<u>DRN Road – 105^{th} ST NW</u>: Corinna Township's Variance request to the State of MN was not approved. <u>Bond</u>: The bond will not include the road work being proposed on Hoyt/ 100^{th} / 105^{th} as the project has been delayed. <u>Highway 55 and Co RD 6 Intersection</u>: Town Board asked Clerk Brown to contact Dick Naaktgeboren to attend meetings for Corinna Township.

<u>Sugar Lake Access Brush Dumping Request</u>: Dearing was asked if the tree material and brush from the DNR Public Water Access on Sugar Lake could be dumped at Corinna Township. The Town Board said it could <u>not</u> be dumped at Corinna Township brush pile.

<u>Sir Lines-A-Lot Proposal</u>: A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Carlson, to accept the Sir Lines-A-Lot proposal for road striping, in the amount of \$6,594.00. Motion carried unanimously.
