<u>Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting, July 16, 2024</u>: A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to approve the July 16, 2024 Town Board Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Bond - Northland Securities — Lake Central Bank: George Eilertson (Northland Securities) addressed the Town Board regarding the sale and delivery of a \$556,000 General Obligation Certificate of Indebtedness, Series 2024A. A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve pre-issuance and post-issuance policies and procedures. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith to approve Resolution 2024-08, authorizing the issuance, sale and delivery of \$556,000 general obligation certificate of indebtedness, series 2024A, at 4.4% fixed rate of interest, date of original issue: Sept. 4, 2024; maturity date: February 1, 2035. This is for the 80th and Hemlock Street paving project. Motion carried unanimously.

Irvine Avenue: No action taken.

<u>Cement Road – Engineering</u>: No action taken. Bruce Markling and Randy nelson addressed the Town Board regarding the status of this proposed project on Hollister AVE NW.
