Approve or Amend Agenda, Town Board Meeting, August 4, 2026: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve the Agenda with the following additions: Cul-de-sac on Hollister; Doug Steinborn – Options for his driveway; Tim and Josh Mol – Shed Permit; Dustin Reich – Washout on Lathrop and Kramer. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve or Amend Minutes, Town Board Meeting July 21, 2026: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve July 21, 2026 Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve or Amend Special Board Minutes, Town Board Meeting June 22, 2026: A motion was made by Smith, seconded by Dearing, to approve June 22, 2026 Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Outlook Report and Calendar: Reviewed. A motion was made by Dearing, seconded by Smith, to purchase tire groover from Tire Service International for \$675.00. Motion carried unanimously. Reviewed quote from Olson Chain and Cable, Inc for \$842.51. Smith and Dearing will look for alternate quotes. Reviewed Farm-Rite quote for Buffalo Turbine KB7-S for \$10,900. No action taken. The following roads will get a second coating of dust control, per original bid: 65th, 105th, 114th, Gowan & 80th. At 63rd and Hart AVE NW – on the south side of 63rd, Corinna will redirect water with 40-50 foot culvert. Schlieff Farms will pay for culvert, aprons, and bands. 300 foot ditch. Use Flygare to hydroseed. 89th ST NW – High concrete driveways – had John Dearing inspect. Should we add gravel to raise roads by Linn AV NW in May, 2027?

Trevor Gunderson Culvert: Town Board needs documents and specific answers regarding ditch restoration by August 18, 2026 Town Board Meeting or Town Board will need to get Township Engineer involved.

6041 115th ST NW, Maple Lake, Request: Reviewed. No action taken.

Cul-de-sac on Hollister: Township needs a formal roadway easement with Randy Nelson and the Barrys to make a cul-de-sac during upcoming road project on Hollister. Engineer will design and the Township Attorney will do the legal description. Take 111th out of Alternate #1 project and put the funds toward the cul-de-sac. Quantities can change – up to 10%.

Requests to be on the Agenda:

1. Doug Steinborn, 11933 Kramer AVE NW - Options for his driveway: Mr. Steinborn asked for options for his driveway. Steve Jost will inspect before Steinborn does any work.
2. Tim and Josh Mol – Shed Permit: The Mols asked about the fee for their shed. It was not classified as an AG building by Wright County. Township will look into this and get back to the Mols.
3. Dustin Reich – Washout on Lathrop and Kramer: Mr. Reich pointed out there was a washout on Lathrop and Kramer. Maintenance Department will look into this.

1. Planning and Zoning Administrator's Report: Reviewed.
2. Corinna Junk Clean-Up Day Re-cap: Report is not ready yet.

Payment of Claims:

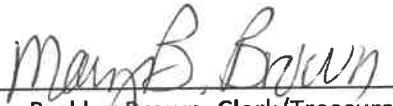
